After 8 years, the rebuilt Kapaia Suspension Bridge is showing signs of wear and tear. In spite of regular cleaning by foundation members, damp weather conditions have hastened wood deterioration and constant use have loosened the bridge railings. We are applying for grants to fund repair costs.
